Requirements

Hi everyone and welcome to The Lemonade Stand! Step right up for a cup of something sweet. This mini club is the program not meant to happen :) But due to popular demand for a mini BOM style program as a filler, we have opened the pop up Lemonade stand... but hey, when life gives you lemons, right?

In the below document you will find all the information about the products I have listed in the accompanying video and what they are used for. ALL information about when things ship, how the program runs etc. is in the Welcome Document which is in the same section of the website as this document.

As explained in the Welcome Document and the video, there are no advance material requirements for these little projects. That's because they're all so tiny! Nearly all of the projects are "fat quarter friendly", in that you will (mostly!!) be able to get the largest pieces you need for the quilts from a fat quarter. Yes, even the bindings! A lot of the pieces you will need are a lot smaller than a fat quarter, and you will be able to use scraps, charm packs and the like to make them, with the exception of the Knit This Tote which requires yardage.

So what DO I need?

Essentially you can just go forth with your printed out templates as they come and whatever you have to hand, you don't need to buy anything. There are however some things that will make your life MUCH easier when making these little beauties, and here they are. Please watch the video for more info.

Optional Template set -

This contains all the laminate peepers and papers needed for the appliqué, including all circles, ovals and scallops.

Applique Tools - My method of needleturn appliqué is quite different than many teachers. I have been teaching beginner applique students for 25 years and I find this method to be quick and simple to learn. It doesn't require much prep, no starch or running stitches or paint brushes or any of that stuff! If you have been doing applique for years then feel free to use your own method, but this is how I will be teaching the appliqué in the videos.

You will need:

- a silver gel pen, scrapbooking or archival quality, pigment ink. Silver only please.
- liquid appliqué glue (not a glue stick)
- milliners needles, #10 or 11
- fine cotton thread to match your appliqué fabrics, 50 or 80 weight

Bias Tape - 1/4" bias tape is used in several of the projects, used to represent stems, thread and a few other things! I sell premade, iron on 1/4" bias in lots of colours - I will also be teaching you to make it using a Hera marker (not a metal bias tape maker). If you want to use the premade tape, it comes in around 30 different colours.

Generally - Sandpaper board - to help stop your fabric slipping when tracing

Lap App - please see video

Wool Pressing mat - for sharp, flat pressing, and for help in arranging your appliqué fabrics

All of the above products are shown in the Notions video, and are available under The Lemonade Stand at www.sarahfielke.com in sets or individually. All of the above products will be demonstrated as they are needed in the patterns and videos.

When does my order ship?

The Lemonade Stand template sets are being manufactured by my template elves as we speak, and I am expecting to be able to start shipping them around mid November. Orders placed from now onwards will ship in order of placement, however we have a good supply and I am hoping to get everything out to you before December in the hope that we can run the Christmas gauntlet and have everyone with their boxes on hand before January 15.

What happens now?

Towards the end of December the first project in the program will have a sneak peek, and information about the first fabric kit will be made available. You can then place kit orders if you would like to.

The first pattern will be available on January 15.
